

Dear St. Andrew Scramble Participant:

Welcome to the Ninth Annual St. Andrew Scramble. The date of the tournament is May 10, 2008 at the Oakwood Country Club in Sun Lakes. It is scheduled for a 7:30AM SHOTGUN START and the format is a four person scramble. Lunch will be served immediately after the tournament in the main ballroom. Please remember to bring the numbered ticket that was issued you when you signed-up to play.

*If you signed up as a foursome, threesome, or twosome, please let your playing partners know this information mailer, the door prize list and directions to the course will be listed on the web site. **WE HOPE EVERYONE HAS A***

Please arrive at the course about an hour before the 7:30AM START. This will allow you time to check-in, find your assigned cart, get a coffee & bagel, and warm-up on the golf range. The range balls are included in your tournament fee. Please, hit only enough balls to warm-up as we have more players than the driving range can accommodate at one time. There will be three lines for registration to accommodate the 196 golfers. Look for the letter of your last name to check in. **MAGIQUE GOLF & HOLE-IN-ONE INTERNATIONAL HAVE A \$50.00 GIFT CARD AND CERTIFICATE FOR A GOLF BAG RESPECTFULLY. YOU WILL FIND THE GIFT CARD & CERTIFICATE IN YOUR GOODIE BAG IN THE CART.**

Proper dress is required at the course: collared shirts and no DENIM, CUT-OFF or FRAYED SHORTS. Each player must have his or her own set of clubs.

IMPORTANT NOTE: SOFT SPIKES ONLY.

Rules of play: Four -person scramble

1. Select the tee shot to be used on the hole. Each player will then play their next shot from an area of not more than one club length from that ball, no closer to the hole. Subsequent shots to the green are played in the same manner.
2. Once you reach the green, select the ball to be putted - each player must play the putt within one putter's head of that spot.
3. Keep the pace of play moving - there are no tee-box honors in a scramble - if you are ready HIT!!!
4. In the case of ties, the tournament committee has predetermined the way ties will be broken.
5. The rules of golf will govern all other areas of play. Remember, golf is a game of honor.

Rules of Fair Play for the St. Andrew Scramble:

1. Each team will use every player's tee shot THREE times: the extra tee shots can be played by anyone in the foursome. Keep track of the number of shots by marking the score card. If a threesome is required to play, the team must use each players tee shot FOUR times. **IMPORTANT OPTION: PLAYERS 15 & UNDER ARE EXEMPT FROM THE THREE DRIVE RULE, AND THE FOURSOME SHOULD REVERT TO THE RULE THAT APPLYS TO A THREESOME, WHICH REQUIRES EACH PLAYER TO USE FOUR OF THEIR TEE SHOTS.**
2. Mulligans are not allowed to be used on any PAR 3 TEE SHOTS.
3. Please remove mulligan tickets from the envelope as you use them for more accurate counting.
